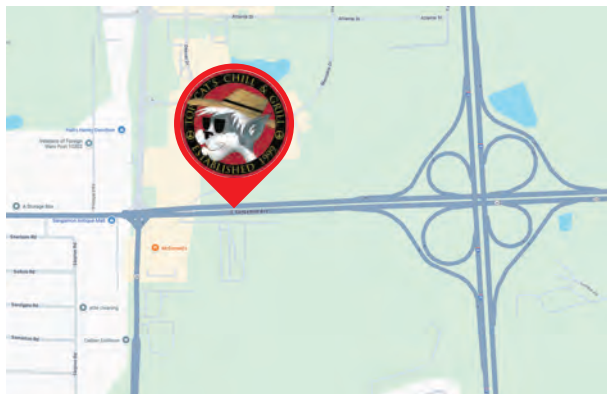
All memberships expire with the calendar year,

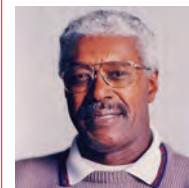
